Building A Building	<b>DATE</b> - January 7, 1933
	<b>DIRECTOR</b> - Dave Hand
	<b>SUMMARY</b> - At the construction site where he works, Mickey has his lunch stolen by his boss Pete. Minnie helps Mickey out with a free box lunch from her wagon. Upset, Pete kidnaps her and the chase is on.
	<b>BEHIND THE SHORTS</b> - A parody of Harold Lloyd's <i>Safety Last</i> skyline antics and the second Mickey Mouse short nominated for an Academy Award. This short is prefaced by a "1933" date card.
The Mad Doctor	<b>DATE</b> - January 21, 1933
	<b>DIRECTOR</b> - Dave Hand
	<b>SUMMARY</b> - On a dark and stormy night, Mickey sees a mysterious cloaked figure kidnap Pluto. He follows through the forest and arrives at a spooky castle. Mickey has to fight off a horde of skeletons in his efforts to reach his dog, the prisoner of a mad scientist.
	<b>BEHIND THE SHORTS</b> - A spoof of the <i>Old Dark House</i> horror films from Universal, this short was considered to be too frightening for young children by British censors.
Ye Olden Days	<b>DATE</b> - April 8, 1933
	<b>DIRECTOR</b> - Burt Gillett
	<b>SUMMARY</b> - This period piece has Mickey as a wandering minstrel, saving Maid Minnie from having to marry Prince Dippy Dawg of Pupupadoo.
	<b>BEHIND THE SHORTS</b> - One of the first shorts to be turned into a musical. Goofy is identified as Dippy Dawg; this is the first short to mention this name.
The Mail Pilot	<b>DATE</b> - May 13, 1933
	<b>DIRECTOR</b> - Dave Hand
	<b>SUMMARY</b> - Through rain, sleet, snow, and bandits, Mickey's mail will go through.
	<b>BEHIND THE SHORTS</b> - One of the first shorts directed by Dave Hand, the supervising director of <i>Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs</i> .
Mickey's Gala Premiere	<b>DATE</b> - July 1, 1933
	<b>DIRECTOR</b> - Burt Gillett
	<b>SUMMARY</b> - Caricatures of Hollywood's luminaries make cameo appearances at the premiere of the latest Mickey short. Among the 1930's stars portrayed are Clark Gable, Mae West, Charlie Chaplin, Boris Karloff, and Marlene Dietrich.
	<b>BEHIND THE SHORTS</b> - Contains the cartoon-within-a-cartoon, <i>Galloping Romance</i> .
	<b>UNCENSORED</b> - Like a one-man militia, Mickey avenges Pete using pistols, a machine gun, and a cannon!
Puppy Love	<b>DATE</b> - September 2, 1933
	<b>DIRECTOR</b> - Wilfred Jackson
	<b>SUMMARY</b> - Mickey and Pluto come to call on Minnie and Fifi, but when Pluto exchanges Mickey's gift of chocolates with the bone he has for Fifi, Minnie accuses Mickey of maliciousness and a violent argument starts.
	<b>BEHIND THE SHORTS</b> - The debut of Pluto's first love, Fifi.
